

The Getty Villa Malibu

The Getty Villa has undergone an extensive renovation from the art collector J. Paul Getty's original Malibu museum to a modern interpretation of an archeological dig that frames the Villa and recalls the natural environment of Pompeii and Herculaneum in Italy, A.D. 79. The transformation appreciates the existing museum architecture inspired by the Villa dei Papiri. The Villa's gardens create a dramatic backdrop for the classically inspired architecture allowing visitors to experience an ancient Mediterranean landscape.
